## Compass Bearing Course Descriptions

A Compass Bearing Course will be indicated by the race committee vessel displaying a yellow flag with the letters 'CB'.

A board on the stern of the committee vessel will show the approximate compass bearing to Mark 1.

A separate board on the stern of the committee vessel will show the course being 'W', 'L', or 'M' with a numeral indicating the number of laps.

The start line and finish line for an 'L' course will be positioned below Marks 2S and 2P.

The start line for a 'W' course will be positioned below Marks 2S and 2P and the finish line above Mark 1.

The start line and finish line for 'M' course will be positioned so as to allow a fair start, 1<sup>st</sup> leg and finish leg.





## Course Diagram – Compass Bearing ‘L’ and ‘W’ Courses


Note: Course diagram is NOT to scale and shows approximate mark locations only.

Start Line – ‘W’ & ‘L’ Courses & Finish Line – ‘L’ Course





Mark 1 is rounded to port. Mark 2P is to be passed to port and Mark 2S is to be passed to starboard by sailing between the marks from the direction of Mark 1. If there is only one gate mark in position this mark will be rounded to port.


Skiffs sailing their last leg to the finish on a ‘L’ course are not required to pass between Marks 2S and 2P  
 Skiffs sailing their last leg to the finish on a ‘W’ course are not required to pass Mark 1 to port

## Course Diagram – Compass Bearing ‘M’


